Introduction

This document presents the Content Development Policy for Development Studies. It includes a description of the Library's existing collections and an outline of current collecting areas.

Set within the context provided by an overall Content Development Policy and a related Collection Management Policy, its purpose is to ensure that the selection of resources - books, journals, and other kinds of material – whether print, electronic or other format, reflect the teaching and research priorities of the School and provide best value in both financial and academic terms.

Collection evaluation

The Library has substantial collections in all fields of development studies, and includes books and journals, in print and digital formats. The collection of printed books, including all reading list items, is divided between 2 locations in the Main Library; Blue 2 and the Muriel Stott Centre.

Appendix 1: Provides an overview of the development studies bookstock by classmark, date of publication, and location.

Appendix 2: Lists the books purchased from the development studies book fund during the 2008-09 financial year, excluding items purchased as part of other subscriptions.

Appendix 3: Lists current journal subscriptions in the area of development studies. Because of the difficulties in deciding on what constitutes a development studies journal, it is not necessarily a complete list. However all journal holdings and subscriptions are listed in the Library catalogue, and all subscriptions to electronic journals are listed in its E-Journals A-Z listing.

Bookfund and resource allocations

Book funds are allocated in June/July each year for the following financial year (August – July). This book fund is to provide for all non-subscription library materials including printed textbooks and research monographs, electronic books, and any other one-off purchase requirements.

Journals and other subscription items are purchased from a separate fund which at present accounts for over 85% of the cost of all purchases.

The library has a large collection of United Nations and OECD publications in print. Since 2008, all OECD publications have been available online via the *OECDiLibrary*.

Document Supply Service and Inter-Library Loans

Although the Library will try to accommodate all requests for purchase, books which lie outside the areas listed above or are out of print can be obtained on loan from another library through the Document Supply Service. Such books are usually borrowable for up to 6 weeks at a time. Journal articles and other material not available from within the Library's collections can also be obtained through this service.

Teaching and Learning

The Library will support all taught course modules.

Multiple copies and / or electronic copies of texts will be purchased or subscribed to as appropriate. Subject to copyright restrictions the Library will digitise materials, for instance

book chapters, or journal articles not otherwise available electronically, if required for taught course modules.

Reading lists and estimated student numbers should be sent to the Faculty Team Librarian by July 31 and November 30 each year so any new material can be purchased and processed in time for the forthcoming semester.

Reading lists will be added to the Library's reading list system, *Link2Lists* which provides links to catalogue entries and directly to electronic texts where they are available. Course modules within the Blackboard VLE can link to *Link2Lists*.

Reading list texts can be 7-day loan or put into the High Demand Collection from where they can be borrowed for shorter periods.

Digitisation

Subject to copyright restrictions the Library will digitise material according to its Digitisation Policy. Priorities include reading list items – book chapters or journal papers – and items from Special Collections.

Manchester e-Scholar

The University's institutional repository, Manchester eScholar, manages and disseminates the intellectual outputs of the university. Since the beginning of 2010 all accepted PhD theses have been added to the repository.

Stock editing

Most stock is kept on the Library's open shelves. As space is at a premium, especially in the Main Library, periodic weeding is used to remove less-well used material to store from where it can be retrieved usually within one working day.

Unused duplicates are disposed of from time to time.

Weeding and withdrawal criteria are described in the Collection Management Policy.

Donations

Offers of donations are welcome, but they can normally only be considered for acceptance if they are within the collection areas detailed above.

Other factors taken into account in deciding upon acceptance are listed in the Collection Management Policy.

Recommendations

The Library welcomes recommendations for the purchase of books from staff and students of the School. Purchases are normally made if:

- Recommendations fall within the scope of the policy as described above;
- Funds are available;
- The item is not already in stock.

Usually:

- Only a single copy only of a printed book is purchased;
- They must be of an appropriate academic standard.

For reading list texts, multiple copies and electronic versions will be considered as appropriate. Recommendations can be made directly to the Faculty Team Librarian, or by filling in this form. Journal recommendations are considered twice a year in March and November. Because of the forward financial commitment involved journal subscriptions usually have to be balanced by savings elsewhere in the subscription budget. Recommendations should be made through the School Library Representative.

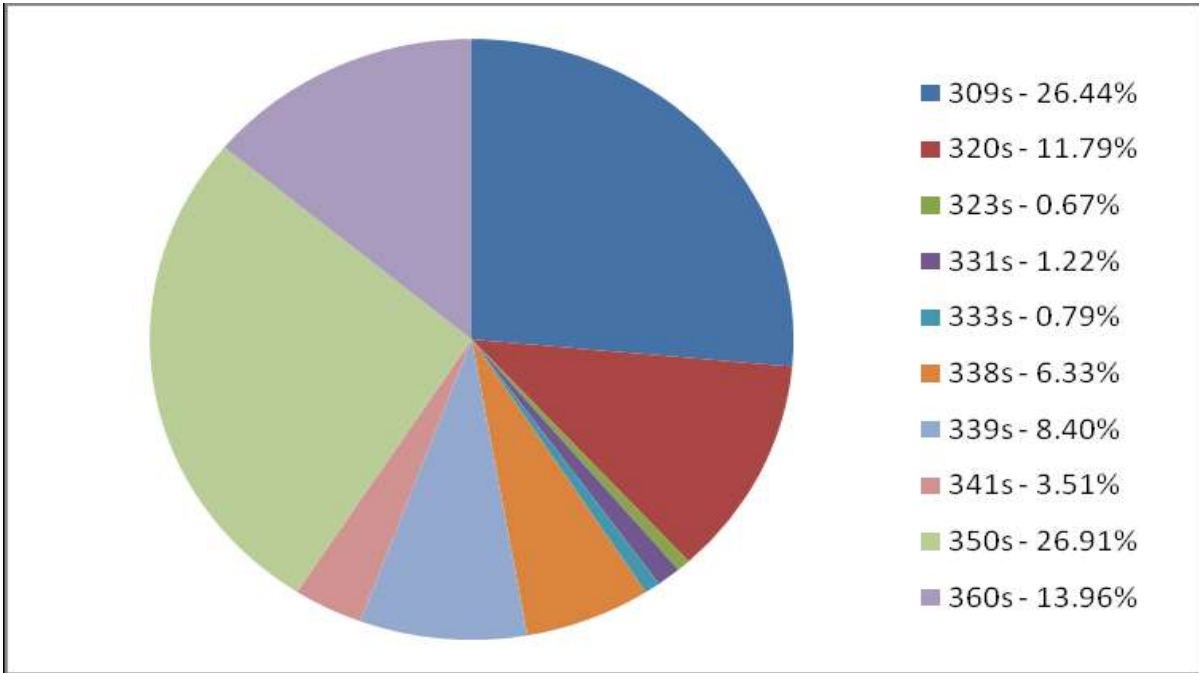

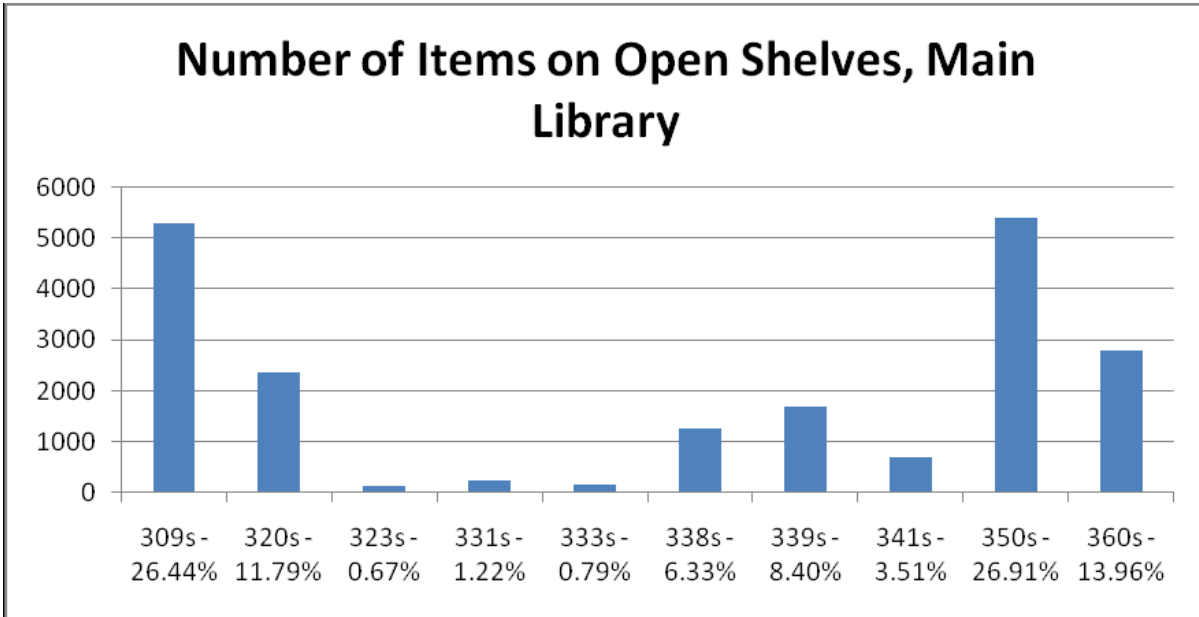
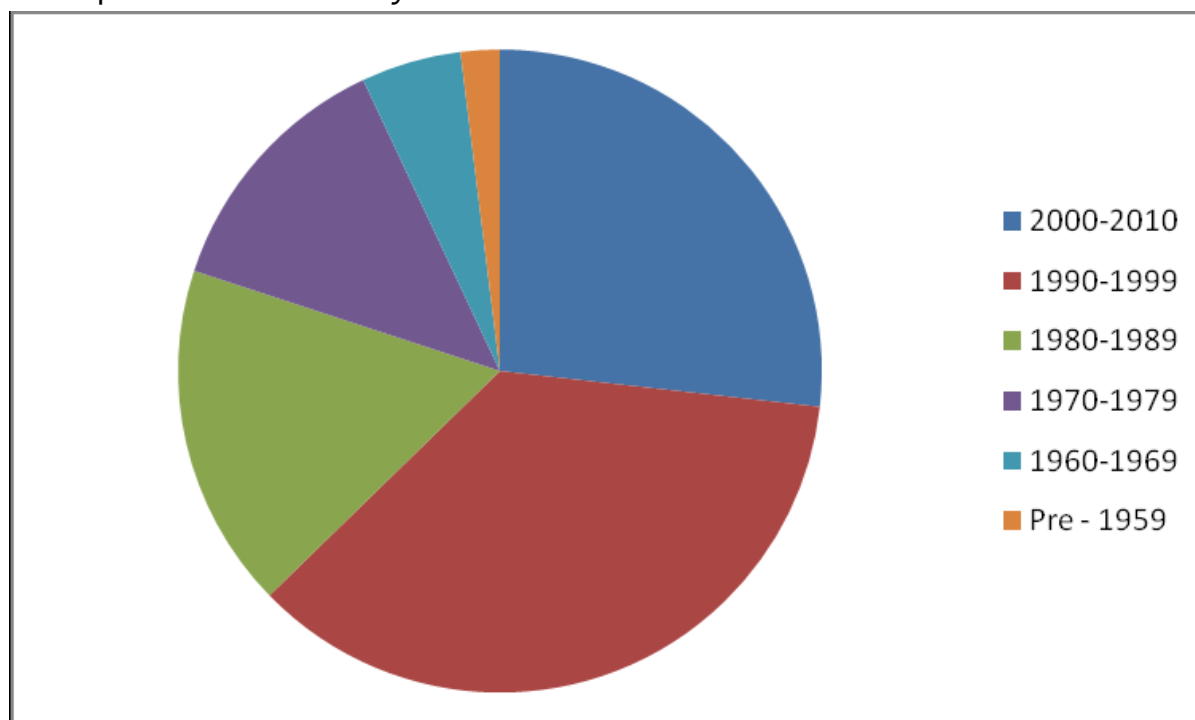

Other Current Subscriptions

Listed here are other development studies resources which are obtained on subscription. They include bibliographic databases, specific and general, and e-book collections.

Databases

General social science databases

International Bibliography of the Social Sciences is the essential online resource for social science and interdisciplinary research. It includes over 2 million bibliographic references to journal articles, books, reviews and selected chapters dating back to 1951. IBSS focuses mainly on the four core social science disciplines - anthropology, economics, politics and sociology - but it also covers a wide range of related subjects, such as agriculture, social policy, archaeology, business studies, criminology, education, environmental issues, history, law and social work. IBSS is especially strong on international material with 25% of references in languages other than English. Over 2,700 journals are regularly indexed and some 7,000 books included each year. Coverage goes back to 1951 and is updated weekly.

Social Sciences Citation Index (Web of Science/Web of Knowledge) This index provides access to current and retrospective bibliographic information, author abstracts, and cited references found in over 1700 of the world's leading scholarly social sciences journals covering more than 50 disciplines.

Social Sciences Index The database covers articles from several hundred key international English language journals in the social sciences, dating back to 1983. Subject coverage includes economics, geography, international relations, planning and public administration, political science, social work and public welfare, sociology and urban studies.

Scopus. Scopus is a database of 27 million records providing access to articles from 14,200 peer-reviewed titles from more than 4,000 international publishers. It covers social sciences literature dating back to 1966.

Specialist Databases (by subject)

EconLit contains abstracts, indexing and links to full text articles in economic journals. It indexes over 700 economics journals, plus collective works, new books and dissertations. Subject coverage includes public economics, health and welfare, business economics and accounting, labour and demographic economics and economic history. CAB Abstracts is produced by the Centre for Agriculture and Biosciences Information. The database covers a wide range of topics including agriculture, forestry and the management and conservation of natural resources. It covers the period from 1973 to date.

Human Resources / Management

ABI Inform is a collection of databases which cover the literature on business, management, economics, human resources and a wide range of related fields. It provides abstracts of material from 1971 onwards and full text from 1987, although not all journals are available in full text. This database indexes over 1,000 journals and magazines.

Business Source Premier This is the world's largest full text business database. It provides full text access to over 8,000 business journals and other sources, including more than 1,100 peer-reviewed business publications. Coverage includes all disciplines of business, including management, finance, economics and international business.

Emerald This service provides access to the full text of articles from over 100 journals covering a range of subject areas including management, human resource management and marketing.

Management and Organization Studies: A SAGE fulltext collection. This collection includes the full text of 38 journals published by SAGE and participating societies. It covers such subjects as business and management, organization studies, strategic management, human resource management and development, organizational communication.

Rural Development

Social Development

ASSIA (Applied Social Sciences Index and Abstracts) provides bibliographic information and abstracts on health, social services, psychology, sociology, economics, politics, race relations and education from 1987 to present. The database contains over 312,000 records from 650 journals in 16 different countries, with over 1,500 records added annually.

Social Services Abstracts Social Services Abstracts provides bibliographic coverage of current research focused on social work, human services, and related areas, including social development, social welfare, social policy, and community development. Inspec is the leading English-language bibliographic information service providing access to the world's scientific and technical literature in electronics, communications, computers, and information technology. Over 3,500 journals and some 2200 conference proceedings, as well as numerous books, reports and dissertations are scanned each year. The database contains 8

million bibliographic records dating back to 1969 and is growing at the rate of over 450,000 records each year. The database is updated weekly.

Encyclopedia of Information Systems This four-volume set encyclopedia, published in 2002, offers general and technical information on a broad range of topics in the information systems field.

Development Administration

International Political Science Abstracts This is a bibliographical database providing abstracts from approximately 900 journals and yearbooks in the fields of political science, international relations, public administration, and public law. It covers the period from 1989 to the present.

PAIS (Public Affairs Information Service) contains more than 450,000 references to the international literature - journal articles and books - in the fields of public policy and administration, including political science, international relations and current affairs. The database covers more than 1,000 journals, extends back to 1972, and is updated quarterly.

Education

Education Literature Datasets The service provides access to 3 databases: *The British Education Index* (1975 to date) provides information on research, policy and practice in education and training in the UK. It covers over 300 education and training journals, mostly published in the UK, plus other material including books, reports, series and conference papers.

ERIC (1966 to date) is a database of educational materials collected by the Education Resources Information Centre of the U.S. Dept. of Education. It covers journals, books, conference papers, technical reports and policy papers.

Australian Education Index (1979 to date) provides information relevant to Australian education. The database covers journals, monographs, research reports, conference papers, parliamentary debates, tests, curriculum materials and reviews.

E-book collections

The Library subscribes to several collections of e-books. The most relevant resources for Development Studies are;

Academic Library The service provides full-text access to a large collection of books in a range of subject areas including development studies, business, economics, politics and international relations.

Blackwell Reference Online Provides access to nearly 300 reference works in a range of subject areas including business & management, economics, gender studies, and politics.

Elsevier ScienceDirect Books Offers access to a range of books in social sciences, economics, business and management.

Net Library This service provides full-text access to over 10,000 books, plus over 340 publicly accessible e-books in a range of subject areas. It is possible to search the entire collection or to search within a specific title. The publishers represented include Blackwells, Cambridge University Press, Oxford University Press, Elsevier, Taylor and Francis, McGraw-Hill and Wiley.

OECD Books Provides full-text access to books published by the OECD in a range of subject areas including development, emerging economies, economics, information technology, environment and sustainable development, governance, social issues and statistics.

Oxford Scholarly Online Offers over 920 complete and fully searchable Oxford University Press books covering several subject areas, including economics, finance and political science.

Springer This service provides access to a large number of books in a range of subject areas including business, economics and social sciences.
