Introduction

This document presents the Content Development Policy for the Discipline of Chinese Studies. It includes a description of the Library's existing collections and an outline of current collecting areas.

Set within the context provided by an overall [Content Development Policy](#) and a related [Collection Management Policy](#), its purpose is to ensure that the selection of resources - books, journals, and other kinds of material – whether print, electronic or other format, reflect the teaching and research priorities of the Discipline and provide best value in both financial and academic terms.

Collection evaluation

Overview of Chinese studies at JRUL

The Library has substantial collections in all fields of Chinese Studies, and includes books and journals, in print and digital formats. The principal collection of printed books, including all reading list items, is kept on purple 2 in the Main Library. Material specifically for Chinese language-learning is housed in the University Language Centre, (along with the School's own material). Most Chinese-language DVDs for Film Studies are currently shelved in the ULC.

Appendix 1 provides an overview of the Chinese Studies bookstock by classmark.

Appendix 2 lists the books purchased from the Chinese Studies bookfund during the 2009-10 financial year, excluding items purchased as part of other subscriptions.

Appendix 3 lists current journal subscriptions in the area of Chinese Studies. Because of the difficulties in deciding on what constitutes a Chinese Studies journal, it is not necessarily a complete list. However all journal holdings and subscriptions are listed in the Library catalogue, and all subscriptions to electronic journals are listed in its E-Journals A-Z listing.

Appendix 4 lists other relevant subscriptions to bibliographic databases in the area.

Chinese Studies material in Special Collections

The Library's printed, manuscript and archival collections are of particular value to Chinese Studies.

The bulk of the collection was acquired in 1901 with the purchase of the Crawford collection. 31 **manuscripts** were included. With the Crawford collection also came 57 volumes and folders containing approximately 1,000 watercolour paintings, mostly 18th- and 19th-century, depicting many aspects of China and Chinese life.

Printed works date mostly from the 18th and 19th centuries, although 28 items are dated before 1600. They include histories, biographies, ceremonials, dictionaries, grammar books, and works on calligraphy in Chinese, English, French and Latin.

Bookfund and resource allocations

Bookfunds are allocated in June/July each year for the following financial year (August – July). This bookfund is to provide for all non-subscription library materials including printed textbooks and research monographs, electronic books, and any other one-off purchase requirements.

Journals and other subscription items are purchased from a separate fund which at present accounts for over 85% of the cost of all purchases.

Collection areas

To support the Discipline's scholarly and research activities the Library will acquire material published in the areas listed below.

Culture and literature

- Chinese literature and culture from late Ming / early Qing to 21st Century.
- Cultural Theory, modernity in Chinese culture.
- Cultural policy and artistic practice in 20th-21st centuries.
- Chinese Women's Writing. Gender Theory, Gender and Queer Studies. Migration and Diaspora.
- History of translation; translation and cultural change; translation theory.

History

- Chinese history from the opium war to the present.

Media

- Contemporary Chinese media and films, modern and transnational Chinese cinema.
- Modern Chinese Literature and their film adaptations, women and modern China.

Chinese language

- Modern and classical Chinese grammar and usage.
- Multimedia in language teaching, E-learning Chinese.

Special collections

- The John Rylands Library does not actively collect Special Collections material in this area. Purchases of material are generally considered a low priority. However, donations or deposit of material to supplement existing strengths would be considered

Document Supply Service and Inter-Library Loans

Although the Library will try to accommodate all requests for purchase, books which lie outside the areas listed above or are out of print and unavailable for purchase can be obtained on loan from another library through the [Document Supply Service](#) (for example via the portal). Such books are usually borrowable for up to 6 weeks at a time. Journal articles and other material not available from within the Library's collections can also be obtained through this service.

Teaching and Learning

The Library will support all taught course modules.

Multiple copies and / or electronic copies of texts will be purchased or subscribed to as appropriate. Subject to copyright restrictions (see below, under Digitisation) the Library will digitise materials not otherwise available electronically – for instance book chapters, or journal articles – if required for taught course modules.

Reading lists and estimated student numbers should be sent to the Faculty Team Librarian by July 31 and November 1 each year so any new material can be purchased and processed in time for the forthcoming semester.

The library's software package [Link2Lists](#) affords the opportunity of creating multi-media **resource lists**. Hyperlinks to audio files, video clips, podcasts and the like can all be included in a resource list alongside traditional bibliographic references to print material, e-books and journal articles, which can link directly through to entries in the Library catalogue. Library staff can provide training and support to academic staff interested in using Link2Lists software rather than a traditional word processing package, and embedding resource lists into Blackboard modules.

Access to reading list texts can be further increased use of the 7-day loan period option (which protects them from external borrowers) or by transferring items into the [High Demand Collection](#) [e.g. via the portal] from where they can be borrowed for shorter periods.

Digitisation

Subject to copyright restrictions the Library will digitise material according to its [Digitisation Strategy](#). Priorities include reading list items – book chapters or journal papers – and items from Special Collections. The University holds a Copyright Licencing Agency (CLA) Higher Education Comprehensive Scanning Licence: it should be noted that material published in Austria and China is excluded, although many Swiss publishers are covered by the licence.

Manchester e-Scholar

The University's institutional repository, [Manchester eScholar](#), manages and disseminates the intellectual outputs of the university. Since the beginning of 2010 all accepted PhD theses have been added to the repository.

Stock editing

Most stock is kept on the Library's open shelves. As space is at a premium, especially in the Main Library, periodic weeding is used to remove less-well used material to [store](#) from where it can be retrieved usually within one working day.

Unused duplicates are disposed of from time to time. Weeding and withdrawal criteria are described in the [Collection Management Policy](#).

Donations

Offers of donations are welcome, but they can normally only be considered for acceptance if they are within the collection areas detailed above.

Other factors taken into account in deciding upon acceptance are listed in the [Collection Management Policy](#).

Recommendations

The Library welcomes recommendations for the purchase of books from staff and students of the Discipline. Purchases are normally made if:

- Recommendations fall within the scope of the policy as described above;
- Funds are available;
- The item is not already in stock.

Usually:

- Only a single copy only of a printed book is purchased;
- They must be of an appropriate academic standard.

For reading list texts, however, multiple copies and electronic versions will be considered as appropriate.

Recommendations can be made directly to Discipline of East Asian Studies, Library Representative: Dr Mara Patessio or the Faculty Team Librarian.

Journal recommendations are considered twice a year (May/June and November). Because of the forward financial commitment involved journal subscriptions usually have to be balanced by savings elsewhere in the subscription budget. Recommendations should be made through the Discipline's Library Representative.

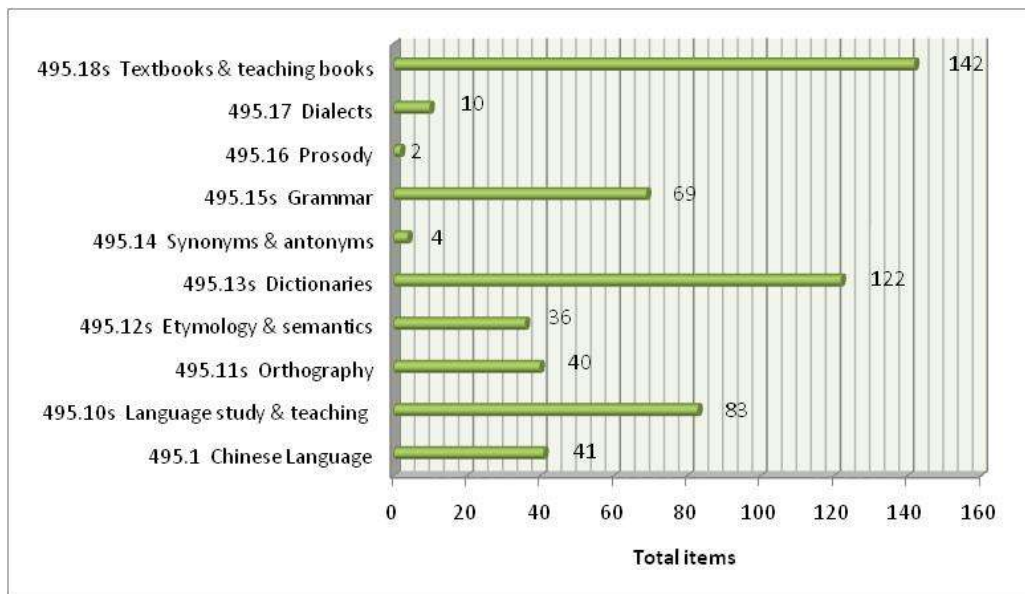

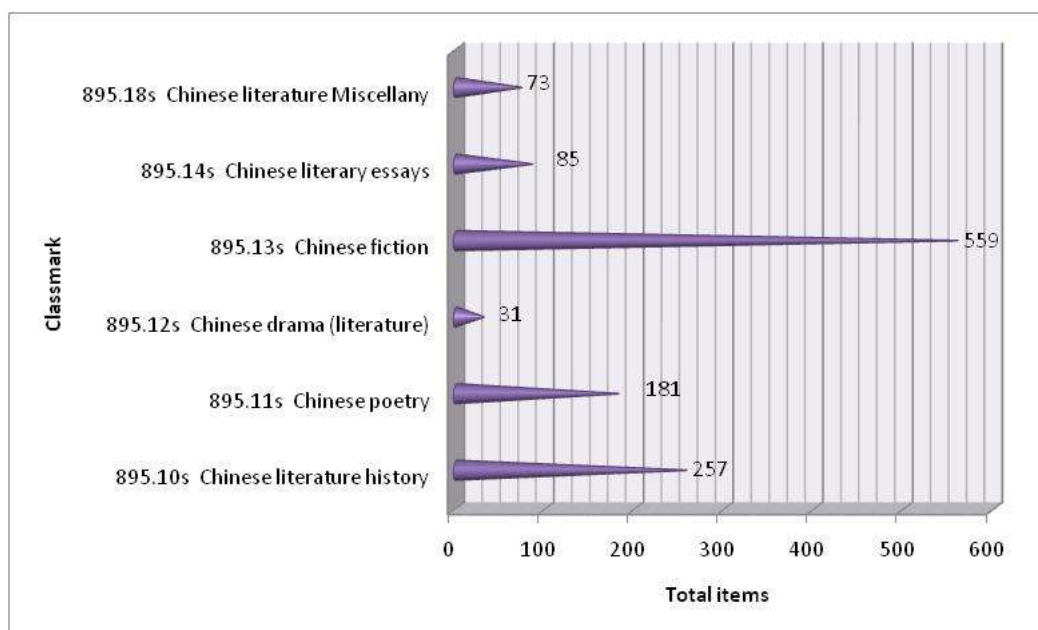

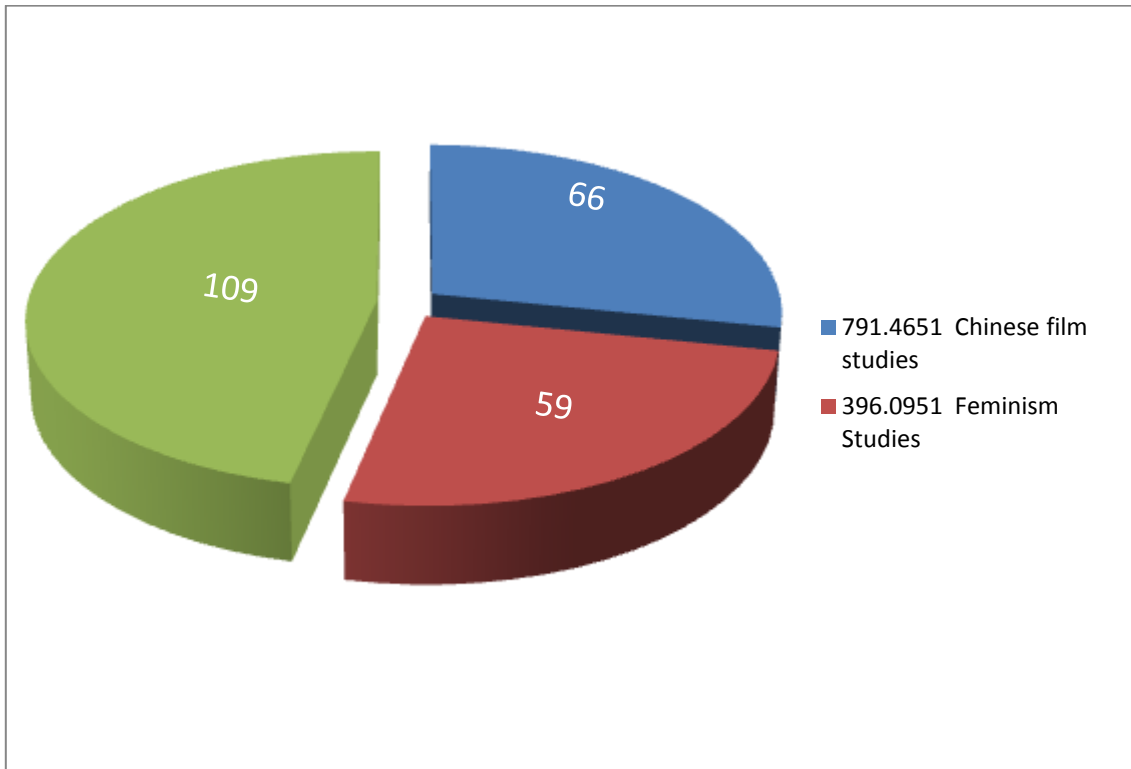
Overview of Chinese language related stock



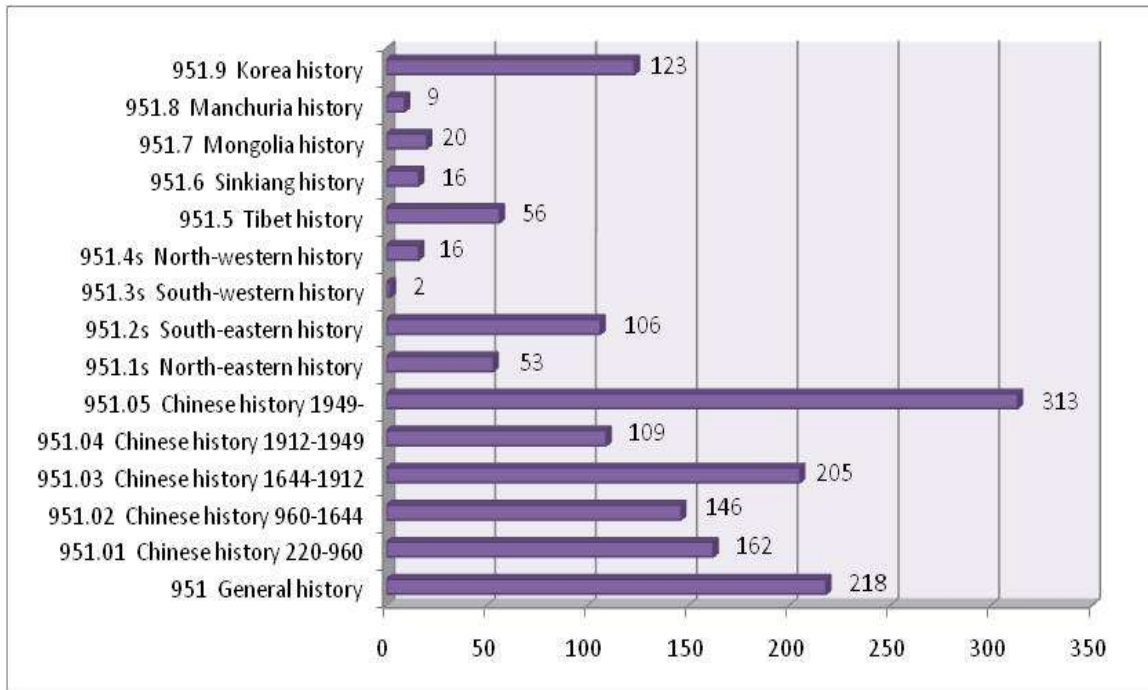
Overview of Chinese literature related stock
